Put your VFP App to the test!



## 1 Play the "Video Tutorial"

## 2 Download FoxInCloud Adaptation Assistant (FAA)

This tool is 100% free to download and use. [Download](#)

## 3 Analyze a COPY of your VFP application with FAA

Use COPY mode to run the automatic code analysis on a copy of your app and post your analysis statistics on our website (these results are totally anonymous). [Statistics](#)

*Do not give too much importance to the time estimate displayed for adapting your application... they are highly over-rated and they don't take into account your learning curve, replicable changes and the fact that certain parts of your application don't need to be web enabled.*

## 4 Check your adapted VFP code in LAN mode

Check your adapted VFP application still runs as usual in LAN mode. *You are working on a COPY, so at this stage make no manual changes to your code or they will be lost.*

## 5 Test your App in Web mode

Install FoxInCloud Application Server (FAS) trial license to test your adapted application in WEB mode on <http://localhost/>. Complete the request form to get your FREE copy. [Download](#)

This perfectly simulates a real web server environment and is sufficient to test your web-ready application. At this stage you can already see parts of your application running on web. However you will have errors since manual adaptations are missing.

*FAS supports IIS or Apache, however we recommend using IIS for your trial since all settings are fully automated (wizard). Deploying FoxInCloud on Apache requires some manual configuration* [Instructions for Apache](#)

## 6 Start manual adaptations of your VFP Source code (less than 2%)

Re-run the automatic adaptation process but this time do it on your SOURCE Code. This very same code will run on LAN and WEB. FAA identifies all lines requiring your attention. Review the results and start adapting the lines of code following the hints and advice provided by FAA for each line.
